The International Interdisciplinary Seminar is a Conference aiming to discuss crucial questions at the boundary of science, and other areas of knowledge. The Communication track of the Conference includes sessions about how addressing controversial issues without raising your voice, and in particular communicating that science and faith can get along well. The conference is held every year at the beginning of January in London with one day in Oxford.

HOW CAN PEOPLE WHO HAVE A CONJUGAL UNDERSTANDING OF MARRIAGE STRIVE TO SHAPE SOCIETY ACCORDING TO THEIR DOCTRINES?
